预期用途

安装

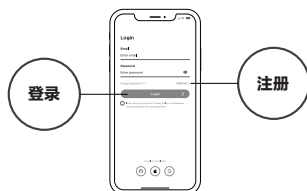

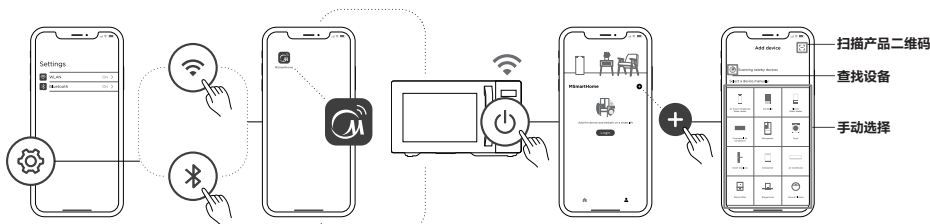

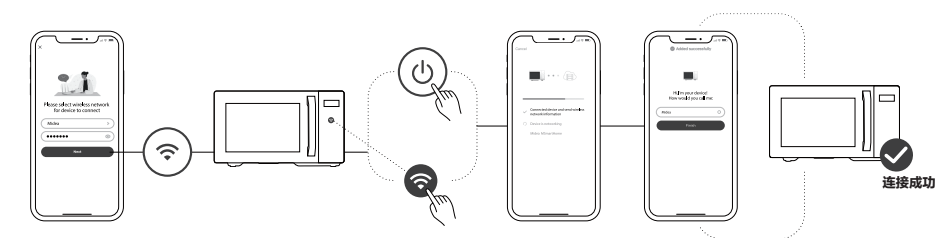

清洁及维护

- 清洁小贴士 —— 快速清除烹调食物遗留在腔壁的残渣：将半个柠檬放入碗中，加入 300 毫升（1/2 品脱）水，放入微波炉中，将微波炉火力开到最大，加热 10 分钟。用软干布将微波炉擦拭干净。


故障排除

正常

微波炉干扰电视信号接收	微波炉操作时，可能会干扰无线电和电视信号接收。这种干扰类似于小型电气设备的干扰，如搅拌机、吸尘器、电风扇。这属于正常情况。
微波炉灯光暗淡	在低功率微波烹饪中，微波炉灯光可能会变暗。这属于正常情况。
蒸汽积聚在炉门上，热空气从通风口流出	在烹饪中，蒸汽可能会从食物中冒出来。大部分（蒸汽）会从通风口出来。但也有一些会积聚在阴凉处，如微波炉门。这属于正常情况。
在没有食物的情况下，不小心启动了微波炉。	禁止在内部没有任何食物的情况下运行设备。这种操作非常危险。

故障	可能原因	解决方法

Names Of Oven Parts And Accessories

Cleaning the cooking compartment and putting the turntable in place. For new installations, make sure all packaging and shipping tape has been removed. Before using the appliance to prepare food for the first time, you will need to put the turntable in place correctly. You must clean the cooking compartment and accessories.

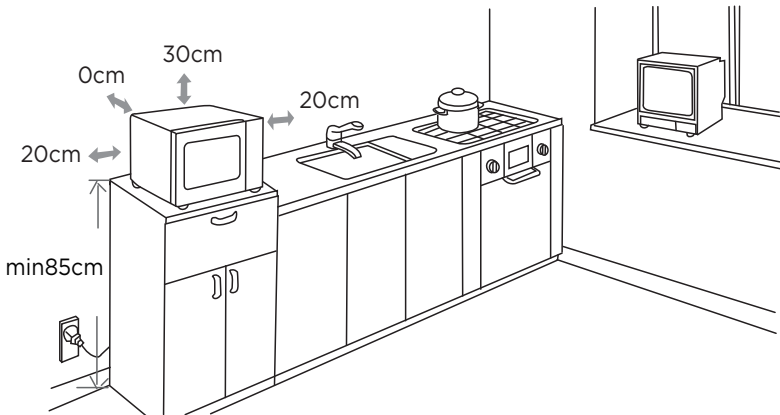
Countertop Installation

Remove all packing material and accessories. Examine the oven for any damage such as dents or broken door. Do not install if oven is damaged.

Cabinet: Remove any protective film found on the microwave oven cabinet surface. Do not remove the waveguide cover that is attached to the oven cavity to protect the magnetron.

Installation

1. Select a level surface that provide enough open space for the intake and/or outlet vents.



- The minimum installation height is 85cm.
 - The rear surface of appliance shall be placed against a wall. Leave a minimum clearance of 30cm above the oven, a minimum clearance of 20cm is required between the oven and any adjacent walls.
 - Do not remove the legs from the bottom of the oven.
 - Blocking the intake and/ or outlet openings can damage the oven.
 - Place the oven as far away from radios and TV as possible. Operation of microwave oven may cause interference to your radio or TV reception.
2. Plug your oven into a standard household outlet. Be sure the voltage and the frequency is the same as the voltage and the frequency on the rating label.

Setting The Clock

1. Press “ **CLOCK/TIMER** ” once and then “00:00” will display.
2. Press number keys to enter the time. Example: To set the clock to 12:10, please press “1,2,1,0” in turn.
3. Press “ **CLOCK/TIMER** ” to confirm. The clock is set.

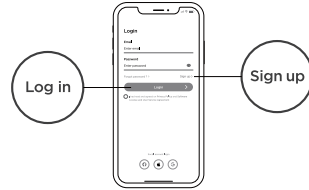

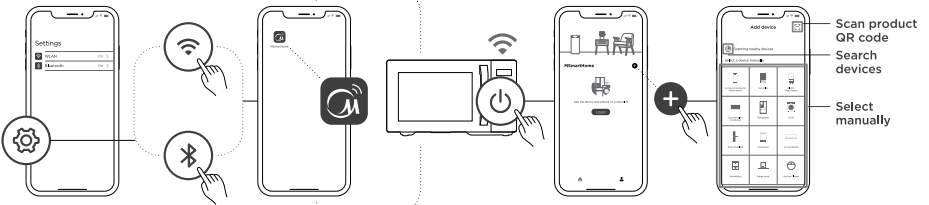
