## Intended Use

Please note modifications or alterations to the appliance are not allowed for your safety concern. Unintended use may cause hazards and loss of warranty claims.

## **Precautions To Avoid Possible Exposure To Excessive Microwave Energy**

- a. Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open since open door operation can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy.  
It is important not to defeat or tamper with the safety interlocks.
- b. Do not place any object between the oven front face and the door or allow soil or cleaner residue to accumulate on sealing surfaces.
- c. Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. It is particularly important that the oven door closes properly and that there is no damage to the:
  - DOOR (bent)
  - HINGES AND LATCHES (broken or loosened)
  - DOOR SEALS AND SEALING SURFACES
- d. The oven should not be adjusted or repaired by anyone except properly qualified service personnel.

## **Addendum**

If the apparatus is not maintained in a good state of cleanliness, its surface could be degraded and affect the lifespan of the apparatus and lead to a dangerous situation.



## Important Safety Instructions

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury to persons or exposure to excessive microwave oven energy when using your appliance, follow basic precautions, including the following:

### **▲ WARNING**

- Read and follow the specific: "PRECAUTIONS TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO EXCESSIVE MICROWAVE ENERGY".
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- **WARNING:** Ensure that the appliance is switched off before replacing the lamp to avoid the possibility of electric shock.
- **WARNING:** It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to microwave energy.
- **WARNING:** Liquids and other foods must not be heated in sealed containers since they are liable to explode.

- When heating food in plastic or paper containers, keep an eye on the oven due to the possibility of ignition.
- Only use utensils that are suitable for use in microwave ovens.
- If smoke is emitted, switch off or unplug the appliance and keep the door closed in order to stifle any flames.
- Microwave heating of beverages can result in delayed eruptive boiling, therefore care must be taken when handling the container.
- The contents of feeding bottles and baby food jars shall be stirred or shaken and the temperature checked before consumption, in order to avoid burns.
- Eggs in their shell and whole hard-boiled eggs should not be heated in microwave ovens since they may explode, even after microwave heating has ended.
- The oven should be cleaned regularly and any food deposits removed.
- Failure to maintain the oven in a clean condition could lead to deterioration of the surface that could adversely affect the life of the appliance and possibly result in a hazardous situation.
- The appliance must not be installed behind a decorative door in order to avoid overheating. (This is not applicable for appliances with decorative door.)
- Only use the temperature probe recommended for this oven. (for ovens provided with a facility to use a temperature-sensing probe.)
- The microwave oven shall not be placed in a cabinet unless it has been tested in a cabinet.
- The microwave oven must be operated with the decorative door open. (for ovens with a decorative door.)

- This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
  - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
  - by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
  - farm houses;
  - bed and breakfast type environments.
- The microwave oven is intended for heating food and beverages. Drying of food or clothing and heating of warming pads, slippers, sponges, damp cloth and similar may lead to risk of injury, ignition or fire.
- Metallic containers for food and beverages are not allowed during microwave cooking.
- The appliance shall not be cleaned with a steam cleaner.
- The appliance is intended to be used freestanding.
- The rear surface of appliances shall be placed against a wall.
- The appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.
- The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating.

## **▲ WARNING**

When the appliance is operated in the combination mode, children should only use the oven under adult supervision due to the temperatures generated.

## To Reduce The Risk Of Injury To Persons Grounding Installation

### **⚠ DANGER**

Electric Shock Hazard:

Touching some of the internal components can cause serious personal injury or death. Do not disassemble this appliance.

### **⚠ WARNING**

Electric Shock Hazard:

Improper use of the grounding can result in electric shock. Do not plug into an outlet until appliance is properly installed and grounded.

This appliance must be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current.

This appliance is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded.

Consult a qualified electrician or serviceman if the grounding instructions are not completely understood or if doubt exists as to whether the appliance is properly grounded.

If it is necessary to use an extension cord, use only a 3-wire extension cord.

1. A short power-supply cord is provided to reduce the risks resulting from becoming entangled in or tripping over a longer cord.

2. If a long cord set or extension cord is used:
  - 1) The marked electrical rating of the cord set or extension cord should be at least as great as the electrical rating of the appliance.
  - 2) The extension cord must be a grounding-type 3-wire cord.
  - 3) The long cord should be arranged so that it will not drape over the counter top or tabletop where it can be pulled on by children or tripped over unintentionally.

## Utensils

### CAUTION

Personal Injury Hazard:

It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to microwave energy.

See the instructions on "Materials you can use in microwave oven or to be avoided in microwave oven."

There may be certain non-metallic utensils that are not safe to use for microwaving. If in doubt, you can test the utensil in question following the procedure below.

### **Utensil Test:**

- Fill a microwave-safe container with 1 cup of cold water (250ml) along with the utensil in question.
- Cook on maximum power for 1 minute.
- Carefully feel the utensil. If the empty utensil is warm, do not use it for microwave cooking.
- Do not exceed 1 minute cooking time.

## Materials You Can Use In Microwave Oven

Utensils	Remarks
Browning dish	Follow manufacturer's instructions. The bottom of browning dish must be at least 3/16 inch (5mm) above the turntable. Incorrect usage may cause the turntable to break.
Dinnerware	Microwave-safe only. Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Glass jars	Always remove lid. Use only to heat food until just warm. Most glass jars are not heat resistant and may break.
Glassware	Heat-resistant oven glassware only. Make sure there is no metallic trim. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Oven cooking bags	Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not close with metal tie. Make slits to allow steam to escape.
Paper plates and cups	Use for short-term cooking/warming only. Do not leave oven unattended while cooking.
Paper towels	Use to cover food for reheating and absorbing fat. Use with supervision for a short-term cooking only.
Parchment paper	Use as a cover to prevent splattering or a wrap for steaming.
Plastic	Microwave-safe only. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Should be labeled "Microwave Safe". Some plastic containers soften, as the food inside gets hot. "Boiling bags" and tightly closed plastic bags should be slit, pierced or vented as directed by package.
Plastic wrap	Microwave-safe only. Use to cover food during cooking to retain moisture. Do not allow plastic wrap to touch food.
Thermometers	Microwave-safe only (meat and candy thermometers).
Wax paper	Use as a cover to prevent splattering and retain moisture.

## Materials To Be Avoided In Microwave Oven

Utensils	Remarks
Aluminum tray	May cause arcing. Transfer food into microwave-safe dish.
Food carton with metal handle	May cause arcing. Transfer food into microwave-safe dish.
Metal or metal-trimmed utensils	Metal shields the food from microwave energy. Metal trim may cause arcing.
Metal twist ties	May cause arcing and could cause a fire in the oven.
Paper bags	May cause a fire in the oven.
Plastic foam	Plastic foam may melt or contaminate the liquid inside when exposed to high temperature.
Wood	Wood will dry out when used in the microwave oven and may split or crack.

# PRODUCT INSTALLATION

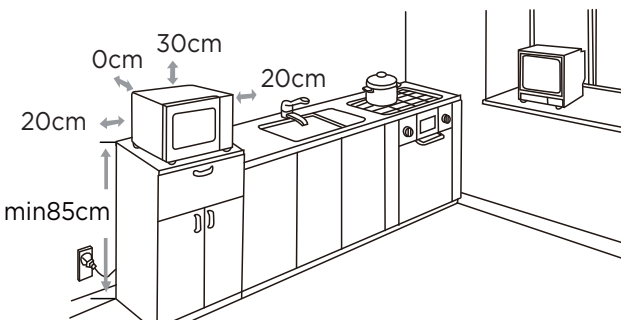
## Countertop Installation

Remove all packing material and accessories. Examine the oven for any damage such as dents or broken door. Do not install if oven is damaged.

Cabinet: Remove any protective film found on the microwave oven cabinet surface. Do not remove the Waveguide cover that is attached to the oven cavity to protect the magnetron.

## Installation

1. Select a level surface that provide enough open space for the intake and/or outlet vents.
  - The minimum installation height is 85cm.
  - The rear surface of appliance shall be placed against a wall. Leave a minimum clearance of 30cm above the oven. A minimum clearance of 20cm is required between the oven and any adjacent walls.
  - Do not remove the legs from the bottom of the oven.
  - Blocking the intake and/or outlet openings can damage the oven.
  - Place the oven as far away from radios and TV as possible. Operation of microwave oven may cause interference to your radio or TV reception.



2. Plug your oven into a standard household outlet. Be sure the voltage and the frequency is the same as the voltage and the frequency on the rating label.

**⚠ WARNING**

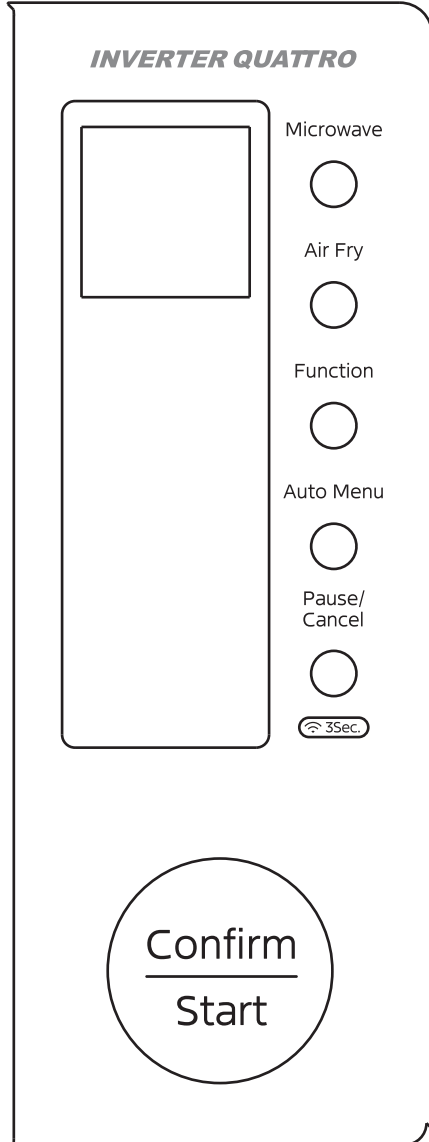
Do not install oven over a range cooktop or other heat-producing appliance. If installed near or over a heat source, the oven could be damaged and the warranty would be void.



**The accessible surface may be hot during operation.**

# OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

## Control Panel



## Standby Mode

- (1) When the microwave oven is plugged into an outlet, “0” shows on the display. The Buzzer sounds.
- (2) In the setting or pause state, press “  $\frac{\text{Pause/}}{\text{Cancel}}$  ” once to enter the standby mode.
- (3) Once the cooking settings are configured, if “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” is not pressed within 5 minutes, the oven will return to standby mode. The setting is invalid.

## Microwave Heating

- (1) Press “ Microwave ” once and then “100” and “1m00s” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to adjust the cooking time. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start heating.



### NOTE

- (1) During the heating process, turning the knob allows for direct time adjustment and immediate operation.
- (2) The beeping only occurs on the first rotation of the knob.

## Air Fry

- (1) Press “ Air Fry ” once to enter the air fry function, the default temperature “ 180°C ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to set the temperature. The maximum temperature value is “ 240°C ”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the temperature.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the temperature. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

## Preheat Function

- (1) Press “ Function ” once to enter the Preheat function, the default temperature “ 150°C ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to set the temperature. The maximum temperature value is “ 230°C ”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start preheating.
- (4) When preheating is completed, the oven will sound.
- (5) Open the door and place food in the oven, and then close the oven door, and based on the set preheating temperature, switch to the corresponding function mode.

### NOTE

After preheating is complete without opening the oven door, it will keep warm for 1 hour. Every 10 minutes, the oven will sound and then return to standby mode.

## Grill Cooking

- (1) Press “ Function ” twice to enter the grill cooking function, the default temperature “ 150°C ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to set the temperature. The maximum temperature value is “ 230°C ”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the temperature.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the time. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

### NOTE

The buzzer will sound to remind you to turn the food over during grill cooking. If no operation, the oven will continue working.

## Combination Cooking

- (1) Press “ Function ” thrice to enter the combination cooking function, the default time “ 30:00 ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to select the time. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

## Microwave Cooking

5 power levels are available.

Power	100%	80%	50%	30%	10%
Display	100%	80%	50%	30%	10%

- (1) Press “ Function ” four times to enter the microwave cooking function, the default power “ 100% ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to set the power level and then press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm.
- (3) Turn the knob to adjust the cooking time. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (4) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

## Re-Crisp Function

- (1) Press “ Function ” five times to enter the re-crisp function, the default temperature “ 230°C ” will display.
- (2) Turn the knob to select the time. The maximum time value is “1h35m”.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.



### NOTE

The buzzer will sound to remind you to turn the food over during cooking. If no operation, the oven will continue working.

## Auto Menu








- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu you need. 30 auto menus are available.
- (3) Press “ Confirm  
Start ” to confirm.
- (4) Press “ Confirm  
Start ” to start cooking.

## More Functions

### 10-1 Steamed Fish with Soy Sauce/Mapo Tofu

- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 24/25. “24”/ “25” will display.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the weight.
- (4) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

### 10-2 Fast Defrost

- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 26, “26” will display.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the menu.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the weight. The range of weight is 100g to 2.0kg.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start defrosting.



#### NOTE

The buzzer will sound during defrosting to remind you to turn the food over. If no operation, the oven will continue working.

### 10-3 Butter Softening

- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 27, “27” will display.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the menu.
- (4) Turn the knob to enter the weight, the default weight “ 100g ”will display.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start softening.

#### 10-4 Fermentation

- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 28, “28” will display.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the menu.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the temperature. The range of temperature is 25°C-45°C.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the temperature.
- (6) Turn the knob to set the time, the maximum value is “12h00m”.
- (7) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start cooking.

#### NOTE

When the oven temperature is above 60°C and then the screen will display “F01”.

#### 10-5 Cavity Deodorization

- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 29.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm.
- (4) Turn the knob to set the time, the maximum value is “1h35m”.
- (5) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start .

#### NOTE

To remove the odor of the oven, the oven will work with fan.

#### 10-6 Microwave Sterilization


- (1) In standby mode, press “ Auto Menu ” once and then the screen will display “01”.
- (2) Turn the knob to choose the menu 30.
- (3) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to confirm the mode.
- (4) Press “  $\frac{\text{Confirm}}{\text{Start}}$  ” to start for 3m00s.

#### NOTE


Before sterilizing, please moisten the utensils.

## Wireless Connection

### Connect the network

In standby state, press and hold “  ” for 3 seconds, till a beep sounds, “AP” will display. If it fails, “NO” will display, and the oven will return to standby after 30 seconds.

### Disconnect from the network

Press and hold “  ” for 8 seconds, till a beep sounds, “--” displays for few seconds, if the link has been removed successfully, the screen will display “8888” and then return to standby after 3 seconds. If it fails, “FFFF” will display, and the oven will return to standby after 3 seconds.

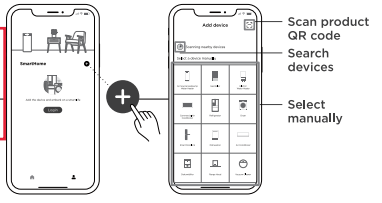
**STEP1.** Connect to wireless network and enable Bluetooth



**STEP2.** Open the SmartHome App. Power on selected device



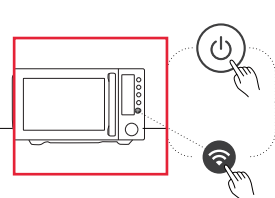
**STEP3.** Add your device using one of the following methods:



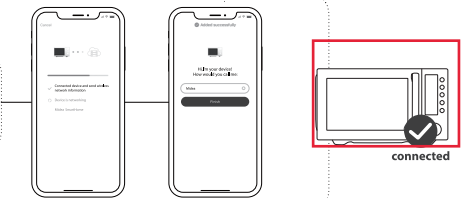
**STEP4.** Ensure device and App are under same wireless network.



**STEP5.** Press "Wi-Fi" button for 3 seconds on the panel. Following instruction to set up, it will connect automatically.



**STEP6.** Rename your device and try to remote control it.



## Quick Tips

- Make sure your devices are powered on.
- Keep your mobile phone close to your device during connection.
- Connect your mobile phone to the wireless network at home.
- Enable the 2.4GHz frequency on your wireless network router. Contact the manufacturer if unsure whether the router supports 2.4GHz.
- The device is unable to connect to wireless network that requires authentication and also appears in public areas such as hotels and restaurants.
- It is recommended to use a wireless network name that only contains letters and numbers. If your wireless network name contains special characters, modify it in the router. Disable WLAN+ (Android) or WLAN Assistant (iOS) when connecting your devices to the network.
- To reconnect a device to the wireless network, click "+" on the App home screen and add the device again by the category and model according to the App prompts.

# CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Be sure to unplug the appliance from the power supply.

- Clean the cavity of the oven after using with a slightly damp cloth.
- Clean the accessories in the usual way in soapy water.
- The door frame and seal and neighbouring parts must be cleaned carefully with a damp cloth when they are dirty.
- Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers to clean the oven door glass since they can scratch the surface, which may result in shattering of the glass.
- Cleaning Tip---For easier cleaning of the cavity walls that the food cooked can touch: Place half a lemon in a bowl, add 300ml (1/2 pint) water and heat on 100%microwave power for 10 minutes. Wipe the oven clean using a soft, dry cloth.

# TROUBLE SHOOTING
